New members without uniform should wear smart clothes and school shoes.

All Beavers/Cubs/Scouts must be with their Group on The Burgage by **2.00pm** and the parade will march off at 2.15pm.

Those wishing to make their own way out to Southwell should meet in the Leisure Centre Long Stay car park by **1.30pm**, so we can walk as a group to The Burgage. When parking in the Car Park, please ensure you park as far left as possible.
